

Tribe Runs To Triumph Over Gators

Florida State's cross-country team routed Florida 19 to 37 (low score wins) here yesterday.

The Seminoles' Tom Graham won the race, running the 4.2-mile course in 22:26, a few seconds off his school record.

Florida's Gene Cole nipped FSU's Bill Nelson by one foot for second place. Both runners were timed in 22:55.

The meet was never in doubt. No less than five Seminole runners challenged for the lead, with Cole, at the halfway mark. Graham suddenly took the lead and slowly increased his margin of victory during the last two miles of the course.

State's Bob Hohnadel took fourth, Sid Merchant fifth, and Dick Carrico sixth. The Gators' top scorers were Dieter Gebhard (seventh), Austin Funk (eighth), and Larry Powell (ninth).
