a lew seconds of his school record.

Florida's Gene Cote hipped FSU's Bill Nelson by one foot for second place. Both runners were timed in 22:55.

The meet was never in doubt. No less than five Seminole runners challenged for the lead, with Cote, at the halfway mark: Graham suddenly took the lead and slowly increased his margin of victory during the last two miles of the course.

State's Bob Hohnadel took fourth; Sid Merchant fifth, and Dick Carrico sixth. The Galors for scorers were Dieter Gebhard (seventh), Austin Funk (eighth), and Larry Powell (ninth).
