

Only one player broke par over wind-swept Tallahassee Country Club yesterday as Florida State's golfers closed in their third straight dual victory, whitewashing Auburn 27-0.

Jack Vague fired a two-under-par 70 in leading the Seminoles linksmen. Bobby Dunn of FSU had a 74.

The Tribe, who recently won the Florida intercollegiate golf title, had previously beaten Stetson and Florida. The triumph over Stetson was also a shut-out.

Following Vague's 70 and Dunn's 74 were Edna Jenkins 80, Steve and Billy Shott 81, 75 and Bunk Berry at 79.

Only two Auburn golfers were able to break 80.
