AUBURN, Ala., May 11—Florida State University's golfers closed their 1957-58 season with a 20½ to 6½ victory over Auburn.

It was the Seminoles' 33rd triumph in their last 35 matches over a three-year period. They played without Captain Edwin Jenkins, who shot a 71 in exhibition.

Three FSU players tied for medalists honors with a 73. They were Bunk Berry, Bob Shave and Jack Shoemaker. Don Smith and Jack Dedmond both turned in a 74 for Auburn.

Berry and Shave defeated John Gross and Lewis Ray, 9-0. Smith and Dedmond downed FSU's Bob Shuman and Jack Veghte, 5½ to 3½. Shoemaker and Billy Shelton stopped Charles Maroney and Roy Abel, 8-1.
