Consistent team shooting-not a single Seminole shot above 75earned FSU its fifth triumph in seven dual staris against Florida. It was the season opener for both teams.

Florida State's Bob Shave (73) outlasted Florida's Tommy Aaron (75) in the feature match between two collegiate All-Americans. Shave finished with one over par when his seven-foot putt on the 18th green failed to drop.

Aaron, Florida's brilliant senfor from Gainesville, Ga., had trouble with his approach shots and took a 75. Aaron was runnerup in the National Amateur tournament last summer-and has been selected to play with the U.S. Walker Cup team.

The match served as a warmup for the Florida Intercollegiate journament which opens a three-day run at Ocala Thursday. Gray lecorded four birdies in winning medal honors.
