

Sophomore Downing Gray put together nines of 32-36 to lead Florida State's golfers to a 21-6 triumph over Auburn here yesterday.

Gray's four-under-regulation 68 was the only sub-par round at Capital City Country Club. Gray missed a 66 when two putts for birdies rimmed the cup on the back nine.

The Seminoles (4-1-1) have won four of five matches with Southeastern Conference foes, tying LSU in the fifth.
