

Florida State golfers boosted their record to 11-3 by beating Michigan State and Purdue in matches here Wednesday.

The Seminoles swept every pairing in the match with Michigan State, downing the visitors 14-1. Setting the pace in that match was FSU's Dave Philo, who shot a 68 to beat Phil Marston's 73.

Philo again shot a 68 to get things moving against Purdue and the Seminoles came out 11-7 winners. Leading Purdue efforts was Terry Winter, who carded a 69 in beating Roger Kennedy.

Next FSU matches come on a swing through Alabama April 1-2. They meet Auburn on the first, then go to the University of Alabama.
