The Florida State golf squad topped six other collegiate teams Friday and stroked a total 580 points to win the two-day Florida Intercollegiate golf tournalment.

Sixteen points behind the winning Seminoles was Rollins with 596 points. The University of Florida was third with 604.

Spurred on by the medal play of John Parsons with a total 142 on the Capitol City course, the Seminole team went on to cap honors with the first three low scores. Dave Philo shot 143 and Roger Kennedy was one stroke back at 144.

Other team scores in the annual event included Florida Southern, 616; Miami University, 623; Stetson, 650 and Columbia of New York, 658.
