

**GAINESVILLE** — The Florida State University golfers knocked off Stetson and Rollins Saturday, but fell prey to the Florida Gators in a four-way match on Florida's course.

With each team sending a team against the other three schools, Florida State defeated Rollins 14-4 and had a even easier time with Stetson, topping the Hatters, 14½-3½.

Florida, however, took advantage of FSU's lackluster showing on the front nine holes to run up a 12½-5½ victory. The loss to the Gators was Florida State's first of the season after four victories, including the wins over Stetson and Rollins.

The Seminoles tried to make a comeback on the back nine against the Gators, but the

performance wasn't enough to make up for the front half. Hubert Green had the low round for the Seminoles with a 69.

Although FSU couldn't take a single individual verdict over the Gators, the Seminoles did manage a pair of tie rounds. Green's 69 and Ron Thilo's 71 matched their Gator opponent's showing.

The FSU freshmen also lost to their Gainesville rivals, dropping a decisive 26½-9½ match. Bob Heuber had the Baby Seminoles' best round with a 74.
