

Florida State's golf team captured double victories over Florida and Alabama here yesterday, winning over each by identical 13-5 scores.

Undefeated coming into the 3-way meet, Florida also lost to Alabama 12½-5½.

Medalist for the day was

FSU's Ron Philo with a one-over-par 73.

However, two FSU freshmen had the day's lowest scores. Bobby Huber fired a 5-under 67 and Mark Lewis a par-72 in leading the freshmen to a 22-5 triumph over Florida yearlings.

FSU's varsity now has a 5-1 record. The Seminoles swept all of their head-to-head matches with the Gators, except for a tie between FSU's Carl DiCesar and Florida's Dave Oakley.
