

Florida State's golf team had its hottest day in history Saturday as the Seminoles downed Auburn at the Florida State University course.

The Seminoles fired a ten-under-par total of 350 to whip Auburn by 29 strokes.

All five FSU golfers broke par, with Dick Stephens of St. Petersburg taking medalist honors with a three-under 69.

Mike Cheek, Ron Philo and Bob Nieberding all had 70s, while Bob Huber came in with a 71. Philo and Nieberding, the only seniors on the team, were playing their final home match.

Lamar Hart was Auburn's leader with a 73, while football star Bucky Ayers was next at 74.

The Tribe plays Auburn on the Tigers' course in two weeks in FSU's final match of the season.
