

## FSU Tankmen Down Miami

MIAMI, Feb. 17, (AP).—Florida State University's swimming team won its fifth consecutive victory of the year today defeating the University of Miami 44 to 31 in Pratt General Hospital pool.

The swimmers from Tallahassee scored in free style events above 50 yards, taking both first and second places in the 220 and 440.

Miami won the 300-yard medley relay, and the Hurricane's George Cooper took the 200-yard backstroke.
