

FSU Tankmen Nip Miami In 46-38 Meet

The Florida State University Seminoles came from behind yesterday afternoon to hand University of Miami its first swimming defeat of the year 46-38.

Miami, with sensational Gay Rosser setting one new pool record and tying another, led through the first four events of the afternoon. Pat Farrell and Tom Conway came through with a one-two for the Seminoles in the diving to put them out front 23-18, however, and the Florida State squad was never headed from that point.

Florida State and Miami broke even in capturing first places in the 10-event meet with the Seminoles' over-all team strength being the deciding factor. Taking wins for Florida State were Freshman John Baruch in the 50-yard free style, Pat Farrell in the diving, Jack Burnett in the 220-yard back stroke, Freshman Don Van Hise in the backstroke and the 400-yard relay team of Dick Wells, Mitch Sutherland, Pete Dunn-Rankin and Walt Jardine.

Rosser, star of the Miami squad, set a new pool record of 2:15.8 in the 220 free style, tied the pool record in winning the 100 yard dash in 1:53.9, and also took the 440-yard free style event.

Florida State's next and final home meet of the season will be with Texas A & M College here Tuesday night.

Florida State now has a season record of four wins, one defeat and a tie. Miami's record is 3-1.
