

GAINESVILLE, March 9 (AP)—
The University of Florida swim team today avenged an early season defeat with a 51-35 victory over Florida State.

Florida won the opening 400-yard medley relay in record time of 4 minutes 2 1/2 seconds.

Bill Ruggie, Gator sophomore from Fort Lauderdale, set a second record with 2:19.5 in the 200-yard backstroke.

Florida State's Ryan Ray was outstanding, winning the 50-yard freestyle, taking second in the 100-yard freestyle, and swimming on the winning 400-yard freestyle relay team.
