

Florida State fought the University of Florida down to the wire here Saturday night before dropping a 56-39, decision to the Gator swimmers.

Leading 44-35 with 2 events to go Florida broke the meet wide open, outscoring FSU 12-4 in the last two events. A total of seven records were broken—six by the Gators and one by FSU. Jerry Livingston of Florida set a new NCAA record in the 200-yard butterfly with a time of 2:08.6 breaking the old record by two tenths of a second.

Terry Green also set a new pool record in the 200-yard freestyle with a time of 1:56.3, set last year. Green was the only double winner in the meet, winning the 100-yard freestyle also.

Other Florida swimmers to set records were: Dick Rarwell in the 200-yard backstroke with a time of 2:08 and the Florida 400-yard Medley Relay team with a time of 3:51.6.

Florida State's lone record was set by Gene Dayton in the 500-yard freestyle with a time of 5:51.9 setting a new school record. The old record was held by Dayton, who set it earlier this year with a 5:46.7.

Florida won a total of nine events defeating FSU for only the fourth time in 15 dual meets. The loss brings the Seminoles record for the season to 4-2, while Florida has an unblemished slate of 5-0.

The top individuals in the meet and Neal Allen of FSU. Allen a sophomore diver from West Palm Beach has copped his specialty for the sixth straight time this year. He has yet to lose as a varsity diver.

Florida State had better luck in the freshman meet, besting the Gators by a 51-44 margin.

The top individuals for the Baby Seminoles was Bob Abbott who set a new pool record in the 200-yard freestyle with a time of outcome of the meet was in doubt until FSU in the last event, the 200-yard freestyle relay, topped the Baby Gators.

The FSU frosh now have a 3-0 record while the loss was the first for the Florida Frosh in three dual meets.
