

Florida State's swimmers ignored advance press notices and soundly defeated Florida's Gators 63-29 here last night.

It was the first defeat in two seasons for Florida's Southeastern Conference champions who had won six meets before meeting the Seminoles last night.

The issue was never in doubt from the time Mike Blouin overtook Florida's Jim Roos in the final leg of the opening 400-yard medley relay, until Richard Abbott coasted home with a victory in the 400-yard freestyle relay.

Florida State won eight of the eleven events and took six second places over the Gators.

Abbott, FSU's heralded sophomore, was unveiled for the first time in his specialty, the 200 yard individual medley. The Lyndon, Ky., native responded with a 2:05.9 time, breaking a school records set by All-American Buck Hiles in 1961.

Abbott also swam a leg on the record breaking medley relay team, and anchored the freestyle relay for the Seminoles.

Another soph, Jim Mauldin, was the meet's only double winner with victories in the 100 and 200 yard freestyle events, setting a pool record of 50.1 in the latter.

Veterans Gene Dayton and Doug Kruger shattered records in the 500 yard freestyle and 200 yard breaststroke respectively.

Diver Neal Allen was near perfect off the springboard, and won easily over Florida's Lansing Price. Sophomore Larry Profumo finished third.

Florida's two-time All-American Jerry Livingston would not be denied in the 50 yard freestyle, although he finished third behind Mauldin and Blouin in the 100.

Other Florida winners were Dick Farwell, who set a meet and pool record in the 200 yard backstroke, and Ray Whitehouse in the 200-yard butterfly.

The victory maintained FSU's perfect record which now stands at 3-0. It was the Seminoles' first victory over a Florida team in any sport this school year.

Florida's freshmen defeated FSU in a preliminary meet, 61-34.
