

GAINESVILLE—Florida's home-pool advantage went for naught yesterday as Florida State's swimming team swept by the Gators 70-25.

The score was the same as that registered by the two teams in the season's opening meet held at the FSU pool.

Coach Bim Stults' Seminoles won all but three events to dominate the meet from the start. The FSU freshmen, hampered by illness to key personnel, were defeated 69-38.



Abbott, FSU's most versatile swimmer, added another record to his list with a 5:11.9 time in the 500 yard freestyle. Abbott, who held or shared as many as five school records during his three years at FSU, was swimming the event for his first time in competition.

Abbott also won his specialty, the 200 yard individual medley in meet record time of 2:04.4, anchored the winning medley relay team.

The meet's only other double winner was Florida's All American Tom Doguardi, who took the 50 and 100 yard freestyle events as expected.

Blanchard Tual took Florida's only other first place with a victory in the 200 yard backstroke, despite an effort by FSU's Terry Schlichenmaier which would have set a Seminole record had he won.

Doguardi was contested vigorously by FSU soph Seeley Feldmeyer in the 100 free. Feldmeyer led for three lengths but

the Gator star had too much at the end.

Another Seminole sophomore, Duane McAllister remained undefeated off the three meter diving board. Junior Bob Cruickshank took second.

The Seminoles finished the dual meet season with a 7-1 record, losing only to N.C. State. Florida State has won 24 of its last 25 swimming meets.

Florida's Andy McPherson won the 50 and 100 yard freestyles to lead the Gator freshmen over the Baby Seminoles. Steve McNerney set a new FSU freshman record in the 400 yard freestyle with time of 4:04.9.
