RALEIGH, N.C. — North Carolina State swept to 13 first places in 16 events Friday to hand Florida State's swim team a 69-44 setback.

The Seminoles, now 2-2 for the season, go against the University of North Carolina this afternoon at Chapel Hill. The meet begins at 3 p.m.

Florida State took the top two places in both the diving events — 1 meter and 3 meters — and first in the 400-yard.

Howard Acosta was first in the 1-meter event, with Ken Von Roenn second, while Randy Stewart took the top spot in the 3-meter event and Phil Boggs was second.

The 400-yard freestyle relay team is made up of Dean Jerger, Bob Bell, Ken Palmer, and Lee Eisinger.

Seeley Feldmeyer, Florida State's 200-yard free-style ace, lost in that event for the first time in his varsity career. All-America Steve Rerych took the event in 1:46.7, while Feldmeyer was second.

Bob Birabrauer, a highlythought-of N.C. State freshman, took two first places for the undefeated and nationally ranked Wolfpack — the 50-yard freestyle in :22.2 and the 100-yard freestyle in :47.5.

Bob Hounsell of N.C. State also outduelled FSU's ace Steve McNerney in the 100-yard freestyle.
