Florida State limited Georgia to three points in the first four events Saturday afterhoon and then hung on to take a 58-51 swimming victory from the Bulldogs.

Both teams showed the effects of the cold 35 degree weather during the meet at the outdoor University Union Pool.

The Seminoles captured the opening medley relay and then took the first two places in the next three events to take, a commanding 31-3 lead.

Head Coach Bim Stults then pulled many of his top/

swimmers from the competition as Georgia began

chipping away at the big lead.

The Bulldogs actually won more events than the Tribe, taking seven of 13, but they could never get closer than the final seven point deficit.

One meet record fell, that going to Georgia backstroker Ross Bradtord, who clipped four seconds off the old standard with a 2:06.074 clocking.

The Seminoles now begin preparations for next Saturday's meet here with Florida's powerful swimmers.
