

## Seminoles Beat USF Swimmers

The University of South Florida won seven events, but came up on the short end of a 63-50 score against the Florida State Seminole swimmers yesterday in a Natatorium meet.

"Depth," said USF coach Bob Grindey, "that was the difference. They had more than we did."

Freshmen John Connelly and Paul Celotto won two events apiece for the Brahman with Connelly, a Clearwater native, going under 10 minutes in the gruelling 1,000-meter freestyle to set both a pool and varsity record. His time was 9:57.8.

Connelly also won the 500 free while Celotto won the 50 and 100 yard freestyles and swam the second leg on USF's 400 free relay team.
