

FSU Second In Swimming

T A M P A — Florida State qualified three swimmers for the NCAA Indoor Championships and takes a second place 221 into today's final round of the National Independent Championships here at the University of South Florida.

Steve Rosenbaum qualified with a winning 51.65 in the 100-yard butterfly. John Hegert and Cliff Schlak qualified with 1:43.74 and 1:43.54, respectively, in the 200 free style. The indoor championships are March 27-29 in Long Beach, Calif.

Florida State is second behind Miami's 325 in the nine-team field. Southern Illinois at Carbondale is third at 152 and Tulane is fourth at 144.
