

FSU swimmers win dual meets

TAMPA — The Florida State men's and women's swim teams swept to dual-meet wins Saturday over the South Florida and Indian River Community College at the USF pool.

The Seminoles won all but one event and beat Indian River 74-37 and USF 78-34 while the Lady Seminoles ripped Indian River 85-62 and USF 87-60.

For the FSU men, Dan Neimer won the 1,650-yard freestyle in 16:25.75, Ed Coryell won the 200 free in 1:47.44 and freshman Dan Acre won the 50 free in 21.68 and the 100 free in 47.68. Also, Chris Chain won the 400 IM in 4:18.28, Chris McGregor won the 1-meter diving with 314.20 points and Sam Seiple won the 100 free in 50.72.

Clark Morris won the 100 back in 55.73, freshman Scott Kerr won the 500 free in 4:48.05, Randy Chambers won the 3-meter diving with 306.0 points. In the 100 breast, Joe Eberling won in 1:01.91. Kerr, Eberling and the FSU free relay team swam exhibition so they wouldn't score.

The women's team was paced by Lisa Nencioni, Kim Foster and Sharon Spuler. Nencioni (100 breast, fly and IM) and Foster (100 and 200 back, 400 IM) were three-time winners, with Spuler claiming victories in the 50 and 100 free.
