

Florida defeats FSU

Olympian Mike Heath won both the 100 and 200-freestyle events to lead the University of Florida to a 66-45 win over Florida State in men's collegiate swimming Friday at FSU's Stults Aquatic Center.

Florida's victory in the men's meet gave the Gators a clean sweep for the afternoon, as the Lady Gators beat the Lady Seminoles 63-45 in the opening meet. Both Gator teams went to 3-0 with the victories; while the FSU men dropped to 1-3 and the Lady Seminoles fell to 2-2.

In the men's 1650 freestyle, Florida Matt's Cetlinski qualified for this year's NCAA championship with a 15:14.67 clocking. Teammate Jason Gorrie also qualified for NCAA's with his second-place time of 15:22.25. Mike Russell set a new FSU record in the event with a third-place time of 15:42.3.

FSU's Sara Linke was a double winner in the women's events, winning the 200 individual medley and swimming a leg on the winning 400-freestyle relay team. Albert Maestre doubled for the Florida men, winning the 50 freestyle and swimming a leg on the 400-medley relay.
