

Florida's powerful tennis team handed FSU's netters a 7-2 defeat yesterday afternoon on the Seminole courts, but the Gators found some unexpected opposition.

FSU's Lex Hester, playing in the top spot, handed Florida's Dick Leslie his second loss of the current season, turning the Gator star back, 7-5, 6-2, 6-4.

The match was the final home showing of the season for the Seminoles, who will wind up their season with a four-match road trip April 24-27 against Mercer, Georgia, Georgia Tech, and Emory.
