

Perennially powerful University of Miami snapped the FSU tennis streak at 10 by stroking to a 7-2 victory on their home courts Monday afternoon.

Miami's Jamie Fillol and Pat Kramer, nationally ranked among U.S. male players, paced the team triumph with individual singles wins and a doubles victory.

Fillol's heavy topspin forehand and stinging backhand were too consistent for Seminole ace Dave Danielson. Despite effective changes of pace, lobs, and drop shots in the second set by Danielson, the Fillol attack led to a 6-1, 7-5 victory.

Kramer ended the 14-match winning string of FSU's Herb Rapp at the No. 2 position, by pounding a 7-5, 6-1 win. Kramer's steady service and cleanly placed ground strokes were more than enough to counteract Rapp's insistent net attack and long-armed volleying.

The doubles victory executed by Fillol-Kramer clinched Miami's team triumph, since the Hurricanes had garnered four of the five necessary points during singles play. The Tribe's Danielson and Al Procopio were no match for the court maneuvering and crisp volleys of the Miami pair, as they suffered a 6-1, 6-2 defeat.

Despite the team loss, John DeZeeuw and Scott Bristol captured notable singles wins for the Tribe. DeZeeuw pressed insistently to the net to defeat Sven Ginman, 6-4, 6-1. The freshman Seminole outclassed his more experienced foe with spinning serves, deep forehands, and crosscourt volleys which Ginman could not touch.

Bristol registered his 16th victory in 17 team matches by downing Estaban Fillol, Jamie's younger brother, 6-4, 6-2. The errorless quality of Bristol's ground strokes and reliability of his overhead smash were largely responsible for the win.
