April 14, 2006 TALLAHASSEE, Fla. - Florida State junior <u>Ytai Abougzir</u> snapped a four-match skid in a major way Friday night, upsetting No. 46 Nick Cavaday at No. 1 singles as the Seminoles rolled to a 5-2 win over No. 34 NC State at the Scott Speicher Tennis Center.

With the win, FSU improved to 14-10 overall and 7-3 in league action.

"Ytai has done a great job of playing at No. 1 this year," Florida State head coach <u>Dwayne Hultquist</u> said. "During the last few matches, he barely came up short and was right there to beat three of his opponents ranked at the top of the country. I think he has been playing well and I was pleased with his performance today."

The Seminoles had a solid day in singles, picking up wins at Nos. 1, 2, 4, 5, and 6. At center court, Abougzir defeated Cavaday 6-3, 5-7, 6-2. At No. 2 singles, <u>Jonathas Sucupira</u> beat Val Banada in straight sets 6-3, 6-4. In the fourth slot freshman <u>Maciek Sykut</u> rallied and defeated Will Shaw 4-6, 6-0, 6-3. Florida State grabbed wins at No. 5 and 6 singles as <u>Chris Westerhof</u> and <u>Chris Cloer</u> won in straight sets.
