

FSU LOSES TRACK MEET

Bow To Mississippi College 70½-60½

Mississippi College's invading Choctaw track team took the measure of the Florida State Seminoles yesterday afternoon at West Campus field, 70½-60½, in the Seminoles' only home meet of the season.

The meet was the closest of the year for the Seminoles and was not decided until after the running of the final event of the day—the mile relay. Up until that point the Choctaws were leading by only 5 points and a win in the relay would have thrown FSU into a tie.

Bradford High Man

Of the fourteen individual contests, Mississippi grabbed eight and FSU copped six. Brick Bradford walked off with the honors in the shot put and discus for the Seminoles, and also took second place in the javelin throw. One Mississippi entrant, Halton, took two events. He breezed to easy victories in the 100 and 220 yard dashes.

Neither of the two aggregations managed to sweep any single event. The Choctaws captured the first two places in the pole vault and 220 yard low hurdles, while FSU placed 1-2 in the high jump and javelin throw.
