Southerners Top FSU Trackmen

Mississippi Southern's Southerners had too much overall strength for Florida State University's track team yesterday and came out with a 69-62 victory at FSU's

West Campus track.

The dual track meet closed Florida State's regular sports season.

Despite four first places by FSU's Carlos Fraundorfer and Jimmy Casteel and a recordshattering shot put by Jerry Jacobs, Mississippi Southern piled up enough second and third-place points for its sevenpoint margin. Each team had seven clear-cut first places, with the pole vault ending in a twoway tie between Warren Strickland of FSU and John Taylor of Southern.

Fraundorfer, the Seminoles' all-purpose captain from Tampa, was the meet standout. The slender star won the 100-yard dash in the good time of 10 seconds flat and set a new school, meet and track record in the broad jump with a leap of 23 feet, 3½ inches. It was the first time Fraundorfer, who placed second in the shot put and discus to wind up with 16 points, had attempted the 100-yard sprint this season. Freshman Jimmy Casteel of Avondale, Ga., was FSU's second best performer. Casteel, destined to become one of FSU's all-time track greats, flashed to first place finishes in both the 220 and 440-yard dash events.

Jacobs, a first-string left guard on the FSU football team, bettered his own school record in the shot put. The South Bend, Ind., sophomore tossed the shot 46 feet, 3¼ inches. He had established the ne wschool mark only last week against Miami.
