Florida State's track team paced by Jack Terwilliger, wound up its regular season here last night with 92% to 38% victory over the University of Miami. Terwilliger won the 100- 230and 440-yard dashes. The sophomore from Dade City also anchored FSU's winning mils relay foursome. The victory gave the Mike Long's Tribe a 7-1 dual mark for the campaign.

The Seminoles, who usually score heavily by virture of many seconds and thirds, reversed the process against Miami by gaining undisputed firsts in 10 of the 15 events. One competition — the pole vault — resulted in a first place tie.

Only one meet mark was established; that set by Bill Bennett, the Hurricanes" all-around ace, in the 120-yd, high hurdles. Bennett's time Tuesday-15.1eclipsed his own mark of 15.5, set in 1954.

Bennett dominated scoring for the losers just as Terwilliger did for the Seminoles, winning also the 220-yd. low hurdles, gaining thirds in the 100- and 220-yd. dashes, taking second in the broad jump and tying for third in the high jump with three others. THE SUMMARIES:
