

Juniors Jim Casteel and Tom Keeney dominated the long dashes and distance events as Florida State rolled up and 82 1/6 to 48 5/6 track victory over Florida here yesterday.

It was the Seminoles' second straight dual track triumph over the Gators and eyed the cinder rivalry at two meets each. The schools first met in track in 1956. FSU's freshman shaded the Florida frosh, 9-6.

Casteel, the all-purpose team co-captain from Avondale, Ga., won both the 220 and 440-yard dashes, placed second in the broad jump; and anchored FSU's winning mile relay quartet. He was the meet's top individual scorer with 13 1/4 points.

Keeney breezed home first in the mile and two-mile runs, overtaking teammate Kent Mills to set a record in the two-mile event. Coach Mike Long got an iron-man performance from cold-ridden Ted Keen, who zipped to the wire first in the 100-yard dash, closed second behind Casteel in the 220, and tied for second in the pole vault. Keen was running a temperature of 100 earlier in the day.

Senior co-captain Dick Elwood smashed his own FSU standard in the pole vault, vault-

ing 13 feet, 7 3/4 inches.

In the meet's closest event, Florida's Ron Allen shaded FSU's Doyle Ruff by a whisker in the 880-yard run. Both Allen and Ruff hit the tape at 1:54.9, — good enough for school records for both — but Allen was judged the winner when both the first-place and second-place finish judges tabbed Ruff.

Allen's time erased the 1956 Florida record set by Larry White.

In all, the Seminoles won nine of 15 first places. Florida's Tom Michaels was a double winner, taking both the high and low hurdles. Four meet records fell.

FSU will compete in the Piedmont Relays at Greenville, S. C., next Saturday.
