

GREENVILLE, S. C.—Senior Ron Harrison won the 100-yard dash and anchored three winning relay teams to spark Florida State to its second straight Piedmont Relays crown today.

The Seminoles piled up 100 1-5 points to 77 3-5 for runner-up Furman. Further back were Presbyterian, Clemson, Tennessee, South Carolina and others.

FROSH NIPPED

Furman's freshmen edged FSU's frosh for the title in the freshman-junior college division. The Baby Seminoles scored 46 points, 10 less than Furman's yearlings.

Harrison breezed the 100 in meet-record time of 9.8 seconds and finished with 14½ points for high-point and outstanding performer honors.

The Seminoles, with Harrison as anchor man, won the 440 and 880-yard relays in record time, and the mile relay. In both the 440 and 880, Ted Keen, Bill Davis, and Quentin Till joined Harrison for records of 1.28.1 in the 880 and :42.6 in the 440 relay.

FSU was second in the two-mile relay and the sprint and distance medley relays.

Keith Crawford set a Piedmont record in the broad jump with a leap of 23 feet, 1 inch. Tim Edney was second behind Crawford.

Junior Don Ostergaard was second in the shot with Jeff Clark finishing fourth. Ostergaard and Clark were second and third, respectively, in the discus.

MEET RECORD

Steve Long won the high jump at 6-3 1-4 for a meet record and Jim Maroon threw the javelin 181 feet, 8 inches. Ed Hays was involved in a three-way tie in the pole vault. Edney finished fifth in the hop-step-and-jump event.

FSU meets Florida in an important dual showdown at Gainesville Saturday.
