Stacking up a decisive 50-4 edge in the field events, Florida State's balanced track squad won its ninth straight dual meet, 88-43, over Furman here yesterday.

Coach Mike Long's Seminoles, 3-0 this season, haven't lost a dual engagement since LSU turned the trick in 1959. Yesterday's meet was the first dual outing for Furman, Southern Conference indoor champion.

FSU broke into a 9-0 lead after sweeping all points in the shot put and also scored slams in the high jump, javelin, and low hurdles. The Tribe won nine of 15 first places.

Furman's Dave Segal, a member of the British Olympic squad, was the meet standout. Segal won the 100 and 220-yard dashes and anchored Furman's winning mile relay foursome. In the 100 dash, Segal equaled the FSU track record of 9.6 seconds previously held jointly by Ellis Goodloe of Florida and Jack Terwilliger of FSU.

FSU's school record of 23 feet, 3½ (t
inches in the broad jump. The
second oldest mark in the Seminole book, the standard in the
broad jump had been set by Carlos Fraundorfer in 1954.

Furman's Dennis Patterson notched a track record with 9:42.0 effort in the two-mile runafter earlier taking the mile.

FSU's George Smith and Steve Long tied for first in the high jump with fine jumps of 6-4½. Terry Long scored a first in the low hurdles and a second in the high hurdles to give Coach Long's two sons a total of 12 points in the meet.
