Sweeping all the points in four events, Florida State's track team, closed out its 1961 dual-meet schedule with a one-sided 104 1/3-30 2/3 victory over Florida's rival Gators here last night.

A crowd of more than 1,000 watched the Seminoles record their fourth straight dual triumph over the Gators and the most impressive win of the six meets between the schools.

FSU won 14 of the 16 events, losing only the javelin and discus

competition.

In the process, the Tribe set two meet records and tied a third. Terry Long, hard-working son of FSU Coach Mike Long, racked up meet, school, and FSU track records with a sparkling 23.2-second clocking in the 220-yard low hurdles. It was the best performance ever for the improving junior.

George Smith snapped a meet record by clearing 6 feet, 5½ inches in the high jump, just one-quarter inch below Steve Long's school standard. The FSU 440-relay unit equalled the previous meet record of 42.9 seconds.

Florida's Walt Beuttner established a new meet record with a 154-foot effort in the discus. Osacar McCollum won the javelin to give the Gators their only other first.

Craig Johnson, sophomore, was the meet's top scorer with 12½ points. Johnson won the 100 and 220-yard dashes and ran legs on FSU's two winning relay teams.

The Seminoles swept 1-2-3 points in the 100 dash, high hurdles, pole vault, and broad jump. FSU wrapped up its seventh

FSU wrapped up its seventh straight winning dual season with a 4-1 record. The Tribe lost only to LSU at Baton Rouge. Florida is 0-4.

The Seminoles compete in the Penn Relays at Philadelphia next week.
