The University of Florida's unbeaten track team, paced by Frank Saier's tremendous seven-foot high jump, romped to an easy 97-48 victory over Florida State here last night. Saier, a West Palm Beach junior was the

headliner in a night which saw eight meet and three track records tumble. The Gators, now a confirmed track power, reeled off their seventh dual triumph without a setback. Florida State, which had some of its best efforts of the season

even in defeat, is 1-4 against dual competition. Saier's leap came on his second try and it was, the first time such an accomplishment has been pulled off in the Southeast. Florida, deep at every position, captured 13 of the 17 events. The Seminoles' first places came. in the shot (Charlie Fuchs). long jump (Sid Gainey), triple jump (Gainey) and high hurdles (Mike Kelly.) Oddly enough, Florida State's Bud-Manning set a school record in the high jump with a leap of 6-71/2 and it was only good for a

third place. Meet marks which fell include: javelin (Florida's Mike Burton, 22-111, long jump (Gainey, 23-914), Saier (meet and track record), discus (Florida's Harry Winkler, 161-4), (Florida's Frank Lagotic, 4:09.9. meet and track record), high hurdles (Florida State's Kelly, 14.3. meetrecord and tied school mark); 440 hurdles (Florida's Scott Hager, :52.2, meet and track record) and 2-mile (Florida's Lagotic). This was the 12th meeting between the Two schools and Florida's fourth win.
