Florida State captured 14 out of 17 first places yesterday as the Seminoles romped to a 103-39 track victory over Auburn.

One meet record was set and two more tied as Florida State won its second dual meet of the season without defeat.

Seminole John Snyder set the meet mark when he tossed the shot 54 feet; 2½ inches. Florida State's 440-yard relay team of Greg Kaufman, Doug Brown, Randy Stow and Eddie McMillan tied a meet record with a 41.2 clocking. Auburn's Steve Richards also equaled a meet mark by running the high hurdles in 14.2.

Charles Galloway of Florida
State had the meet's lone
double victory, winning the
triple jump with a leap of 47feet, 1/2 inch after copping the
long jump with a leap of 23-4.

The Seminoles jumped on top early as they scored heavily in the sprints. Auburn had been figured to be strongest in this department.

Randy Stow's 47.9 in a winning 440 effort was his best time and freshmen Eddie McMillan and Del Raimers captured the 100 and three-mile events. McMillan also anchored the winning 440 relay team while Raimers finished second in the mile.

Auburn's three victories came in the high hurdles (Steve Richards, 14.2), 220 (Bobby Baker, 21.9) and 880 (Fran Beatty, 1:55.2).

In seven of the individual events, Florida State gained valuable points by finishing first and second.
