

BATON ROUGE, La. — In a track meet which really came down to the wire, a strong Oklahoma State team edged Florida State 59½ to 56, with the winning margin coming in the final event of the meet.

Freshman Joel Garren just couldn't quite make up a ten-yard deficit on the final leg of the mile relay as Oklahoma State's Lloyd Wills won by only six inches. Garren turned in a good performance as the Seminole entry broke the school record with a time of 3:13.0.

Distance runner Ken Misner passed up a chance at the mile run so he could concentrate on qualifying for nationals in the three-mile event, and the Seminoles could manage only fourth in the mile. Misner won the three-mile run and qualified for nationals with a time of 13:58.7.

Bill Jackson won the pole vault with a leap of 13'6" on a

wet track which hampered both track and field events during the meet.

Other winners for Florida State were Jim Buck in the javelin with a throw of 220'1" and Bruce McCampbell in the discus with a throw of 167'2½".
