

Smith Wins Two For Seminoles

COLUMBIA, S. C. - Florida State's Danny Smith took firsts in the 120 - yard high hurdles and the 100 - yard dash Saturday and led the Seminoles to a second place finish in a tri - meet here at the University of South Carolina.

South Carolina, taking first place from Florida State midway in the meet, finished with 75 points to the Tribe's 69. Auburn was third at 44.

Smith posted a 14.0 in the hurdles, then ran a 9.7 in taking the 100. He also was second in the 220 and anchored the 440 relay which placed second.

Allen McMillen won the pole vault at 16-4 and one - half and qualified for the NCAA outdoor meet to be held later this summer.

Mike Lee took the top spot in

the high jump at 6-8. Rudy Falana won the long jump at 23-3 and three - fourths, Rich Richelderfer threw the javelin for a winning 223-7 and Bob Brooks won the mile in 4:10.
