

Gators rip FSU men. . .

"Florida is in the top 10 in the country and proved it," said Florida State swim coach John Stafford after the Gators handed his team its first loss of the season, 85-28, at the Union Pool.

Stafford, a first year coach out of Jacksonville Bolles, saw three of his high school students, David Larson, David Zubero and Kyle Miller, combine for six victories. The Seminoles won the opening 400-medley relay, with Kevin McConnell, Kevin Marshburn, Larry Brown and Steve Allbritton swimming to a 3:29.92 time, but Florida won every other event.

Florida State is now 5-1 on the season.
