

FSU women beat Florida

TAMPA — Cherry Rivers and Jackie Arnold led the Florida State Lady Seminoles to a convincing 100-80 win over the University of Florida here Friday night in the AIAW women's state basketball tournament.

The Lady Seminoles will play University of South Florida today at 1 p.m., and should they win that one, will play USF again at eight for the championship.

The victory over Florida clinched a berth in the Region III AIAW tournament to be held at Florida State March 9-10-11.

The Lady Seminoles advanced to the semifinals with a 94-60 win over University of Miami Thursday night.

FSU started running from the opening whistle, and the Lady Gators ran into foul trouble trying to keep pace.

Rivers led the Seminole attack with 32 points while Arnold contributed 25 in the FSU victory.

Peggy Brookins led the Lady Gators with 17 points.
