FLORIDA STATE SOCCER UPSETS NO. 6 FLORIDA 3-2 Seminoles come from behind for first-ever victory over the Gators.

TALLAHASSEE, Fla. - The Florida State women's soccer team scored the game-winning goal with less than two minutes on the clock to upset the sixth ranked Florida Gators, 3-2, Friday night in front of 1,282 fans at the Seminole Soccer Complex. The Seminoles fell behind on two occasions before senior April Murphy scored the final goal in the closing minutes.

"Great performance by our team," said head coach Patrick Baker. "We ran at Florida, got behind them and scored three quality goals. I am so happy for our seniors."

The Seminoles and Gators played a scoreless first half before Florida's Karyn Hall broke the tie 21 minutes into the second half. Redshirt junior Heather Dyche tied the game for the Seminoles just 24 seconds later.

The Gators recaptured the lead less than two minutes after the Seminoles evened the score at 1-1 when Keisha Bell scored on a pass from Hall. The Seminoles again came right back and answered just 1:06 later when junior Marte Vik Edvardsen lobbed a shot over Gator goalkeeper Jordan Kellgren.

"Last year we would have dropped after the first goal, we would have put our heads down and it would have been game over," said Murphy. "This year is not going to be like last year. We are going to do everything we can to build on this and make this a sweet year."

As the clock wound down, Maren Vik Edvardsen found Murphy on the left side of the goal and fed her the ball. Murphy chased down the pass and knocked in the game-winner for the Seminoles with only 1:44 on the clock.

"This makes the whole pre-season and summer worthwhile," said Murphy. "The goal was pure happiness. I saw Maren feed me the ball and I ran with everything I had left, and I knew I could get to the pass if I just gave everything I had left."

This marks the first victory the Seminoles have ever recorded versus the University of Florida or a nationally-ranked team. Last season, FSU recorded its first-ever goal against the Gators in a season-opening 5-1 loss.

"Our seniors have toiled with a lot of disappointment in the past and this being the first game of their senior year makes me so excited for them," said Baker. "This is definitely a game we can build on and hopefully we can keep up this momentum."

The Seminoles will return to action Sunday, August 27 against the University of South Florida. The game kicks-off at 1:00 p.m., at the Seminole Soccer Complex and will be televised regionally by the Sunshine Network.
