MIAMI — Florida State's unbeaten softball team copped two more victories Saturday to win the championship of the Miami-Dade Community College Invitational tournament.

FSU beat Florida 5-2 in the final, sparked by a solo home run by Barbara Harris and a two-run blast by Bonnie Craig. Winning pitcher Robin Willy and Cathy Morton went two-for-three to help win the championship.
