

FSU wins softball tournament

ATLANTA, Ga. — Florida State's Lady Seminole softball team won four games Saturday to take first place in the Georgia Tech round-robin tournament.

The Lady Seminoles, 29-5, will take on Lake City Community College at 5 p.m. Monday in Tallahassee.

FSU, 7-0 in the tournament, edged Georgia Southern 4-3 before stomping Georgia State 17-2, Georgia Tech 12-2 and Armstrong State 17-4.

Carol O'Donski had three hits and five runs batted in, Kathy Gooding had three hits and Toni Robinette had a pair for FSU in the first two contests. Natalie Drouin and Charlotte Cates had four hits while Darby Cottle and Robinette had three each in the second two games.
