

Lady Gators win FSU invitational

Chris Olivie went four-for-four at the plate and drove in four runs in leading the Lady Gators of Florida to a 14-6 defeat of Lake City Community College in the championship of the Lady Seminoles Softball Invitational Saturday.

Olivie was named to the all-tournament team.

Florida advanced to the finals after beating East Carolina 9-2. Lake City got there by knocking off favorite Florida State 7-5.

The Lady Seminoles dropped three straight games after losing pitcher Sue Painter to what was diagnosed as decision to East Carolina in the third-place contest.

The Lady Gators dominated the 11-member all-tournament team. In addition to Olivie, Cariyce Cononie, Jan Croud and Beth Brier also were named to the squad.

Other team members were Angel Aycock and Carmen Orihuela of South Florida, Dena Cherry and Terri Fullwood of Lake City and Yvette Williams and Mitzi Davis of East Carolina. Toni Robinette was the only FSU selection.

Florida State, 12-3, will play Edward Waters College at 2 p.m. Monday at the Stadium Field.
