

FSU Spikers Set Tourney

A field of 18 teams from five southeastern states will be on hand for the Fifth Annual Lady Seminole Volleyball Tournament which gets underway Friday morning at Florida State's Tully Gym.

The opening serves will come at 8:45 a.m. in the initial round robin preliminary which will pare the field to six teams for the championship round Saturday afternoon.

Friday's matches are scheduled to continue through 5:45 p.m. with play resuming again at 8 a.m. Saturday. The championship round will be a single elimination affair and is scheduled to start at 2 p.m. with the final game beginning about 4 p.m.

FSU Spikers Lead at 3-0
