

FSU spikers win Florida title

The Florida State volleyball team won the Division I state title Saturday by defeating Miami 15-10, 9-15, 15-8, 16-14.

The win gives the Lady Seminoles a berth in the regional tournament next weekend at the University of Central Florida.

In the fourth game against Miami, FSU was behind 11-1 and came back to beat the Lady Hurricanes for the fourth time in eight tries. There has been one tie between the two teams.

Sophomore hitter Alicia Cross had 14 kills and 7 defensive saves in the tournament and senior Margie Wessel had 17 kills and 9 saves. As a team, FSU had 39 diving-type saves. The three Lady Seminoles who were named all-tournament were Wessel, hitter Marie Sanders and defense-player Amy Davies. Their record is now 40-11-1.
