






COACH BOB HARBISON


H. G. DANFORD

THE DIXIE CONFERENCE was organized last year by the representatives of nine Southern colleges, whose institutions were definitely committed to the principle of amateurism in college sports.

In the present era of commercialization and semi-professionalism such a conference in college football is unique. Yet it is founded on sound principles of education. If athletics have a place in education, then they should be administered in accordance with educational policy.

One important function of a college or university is to help the student establish for himself a sense of values. Subsidized football does much to distort a proper sense of value both in the individual player and also in the regard of the public for the institution.

These are the principles which have guided the members of the Dixie Conference in their plans of organization. Each member is pledged against the giving of financial aid in recognition of athletic ability. The athlete is to be given only the same consideration given other students and is to meet all normal requirements.

The Dixie Conference is in a position to lead the way back to a normal and a sensible administration of inter-collegiate athletics and it should have the support of all those who covet the highest values in sports.


