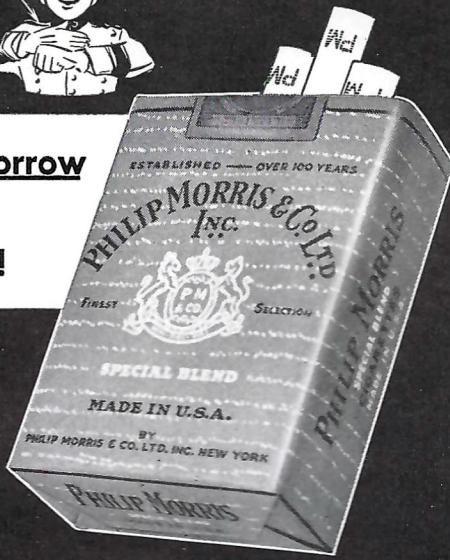

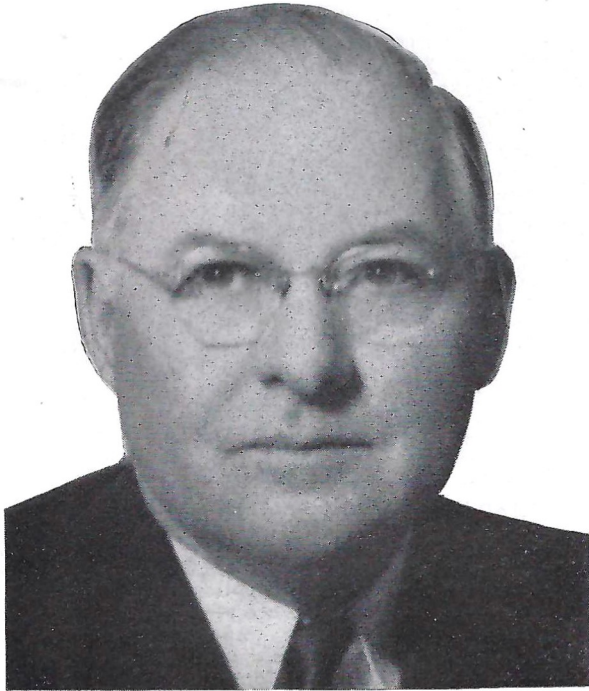

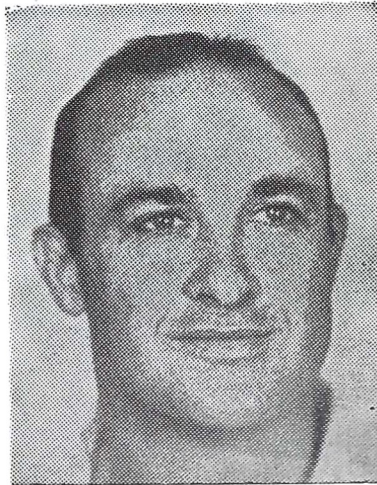


# ★ The Men Building The Seminoles ★

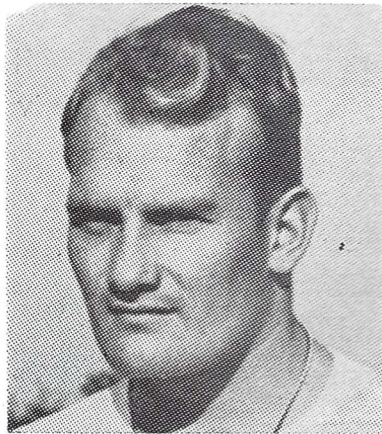
**HEAD COACH DON VELLER**

Coach Veller is a native of Indiana. He played football for the Hoosiers from 1931 to 1935. After graduating from Indiana University he accepted the head coaching job at Elkhart High School where he remained until he went into the Army Air Corps in 1942. After the separation from the service he accepted the position of head football coach and athletic director at Hanover College in Madison, Indiana. He left this position, after a year, to become an assistant coach at his old Alma Mater. He came to FSU in the summer of 1948 to accept his present position.



**COACH CHARLES ARMSTRONG**

An Air Corps veteran, Armstrong returned to grid warfare at Indiana University in the fall of 1945. He played on Indiana's Big Ten Championship team that year. He was a placekick specialist while in college. Coming to FSU in the spring of 1948 he handled the Seminole's first baseball team and spring football practice.



**COACH BILL ARMSTRONG**

Coach Bill Armstrong played on the same Indiana team with his brother, Charlie and Coach Harbison. He finished his playing days in the Blue-Gray affair in Montgomery in 1947. He is working on his master's degree in education and would like to coach football in Florida.



**COACH BOB HARBISON**

Bob (Mousetrap) Harbison, the youngest coach on the staff and possibly the youngest in the country, just graduated from Indiana University this past summer. He was a very fine guard for four years there and finished his intercollegiate career by playing in the Blue-Gray game in Montgomery, Ala., last December.
