FROM THE PRESS BOX

I know one thing all Florida State fans agree on is how special Doak Campbell Stadium is to them. It is not a stretch to suggest that, of course, as everyone's stadium is special to its fan base, but it is appropriate for each of you to relish this afternoon's game in Doak and soak in the experience because it has to last you at least until the spring game.

Joining you in drawing it all in today are the 17 senior members of the football team who will race out of the north tunnel for the last time today. I guarantee you they were fully aware that they were making their last ride on the bus in from the hotel this morning. They realized they were getting dressed in their game uniform for the last time in "their" locker and that they would be seeing Osceola and Renegade, singing along to the fight song and being inspired by the Warchant for the last time in their home stadium today.

All that would generate enough emotion, but add the experience of greeting your family on the field in the pregame, and it's a wonder any senior manages to play his final game.

As of most of us are aware, today's game against Florida is extremely important as a win would mean we extend our streak of consecutive bowl games and have a chance to post another winning season. This isn't the first time FSU is in this position — just last season, the Noles had to win their final three games to extend the streak. That team beat the Gators 38-22, FSU's fifth consecutive win in the series.

It seems particularly appropriate, given the fact that officials were hand-counting individual ballots for the senate race earlier this month, to look at the fact that it nearly required an act of government to get Florida to schedule FSU.

As Florida State University's football program rapidly grew in stature following its debut in 1947, FSU fans began a drive to play Florida that grew louder each time UF refused the challenge.

By 1955, according to the late Bill McGrotha in his book "Seminoles! The First Forty Years," the Board of Control (predecessor of today's Board of Regents) unanimously approved a policy "directing the two schools to initiate and maintain relations in all sports." Apparently that was not worth the paper it was written on as no headway was made in convincing UF to schedule FSU.

The next step was the loud talk of bills being introduced in the Florida legislature to require the schools to play, which Florida State-friendly Governor LeRoy Collins deftly avoided by convincing UF's president to agree to play the Seminoles. FSU president Doak Campbell (see the tie-in now?) had to swallow hard and agree to play the first six games in Gainesville, but the long-term goal meant FSU had to take what it could get.

The Seminoles lost five of those first six games in Gainesville but did manage a 3-3 tie in 1961 to set up UF's first visit to Tallahassee in 1964. As fate, or just plain karma, would have it, Florida would play its first game in Doak Campbell against one of FSU's best teams to date.

Once the smoke had cleared, the Seminoles prevailed 16-7 garnering a sense of pride that had been literally years in the making.

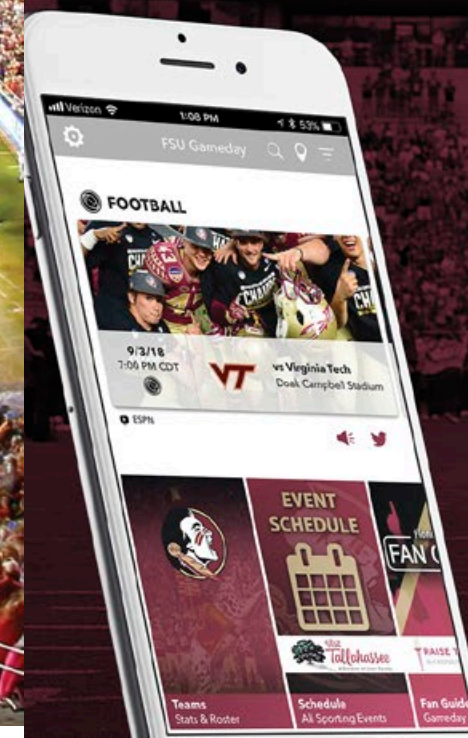

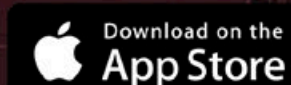

HEAD COACH WILLIE TAGGART

Florida State hired Florida native Willie Taggart to be its 10th full-time head football coach on Dec. 5, 2017. Taggart is considered one of the best offensive minds in the country and has already proven to be a relentless and effective recruiter.

Taggart returned to the Sunshine State, where he was the head coach at the University of South Florida from 2013-16, after one season as head coach at the University of Oregon. He began his head coaching career at his alma mater, Western Kentucky University, from 2010-12 after serving as an assistant from 1999-2006.

Between his tenures at Western Kentucky, he was an assistant coach at Stanford from 2007-09. Taggart has led remarkable turnarounds

at each of his three previous head coaching positions. In the season prior to his hire, the programs Taggart inherited were a combined 7-29, and the best team he took over before arriving at FSU was a 4-8 Oregon squad.

His overall record is 47-50, including a 25-12 mark since the start of the 2015 season. In that same timespan, his offenses have the fourth-highest points-per-game average among FBS head coaches behind only Mike Gundy, Kliff Kingsbury and Urban Meyer.

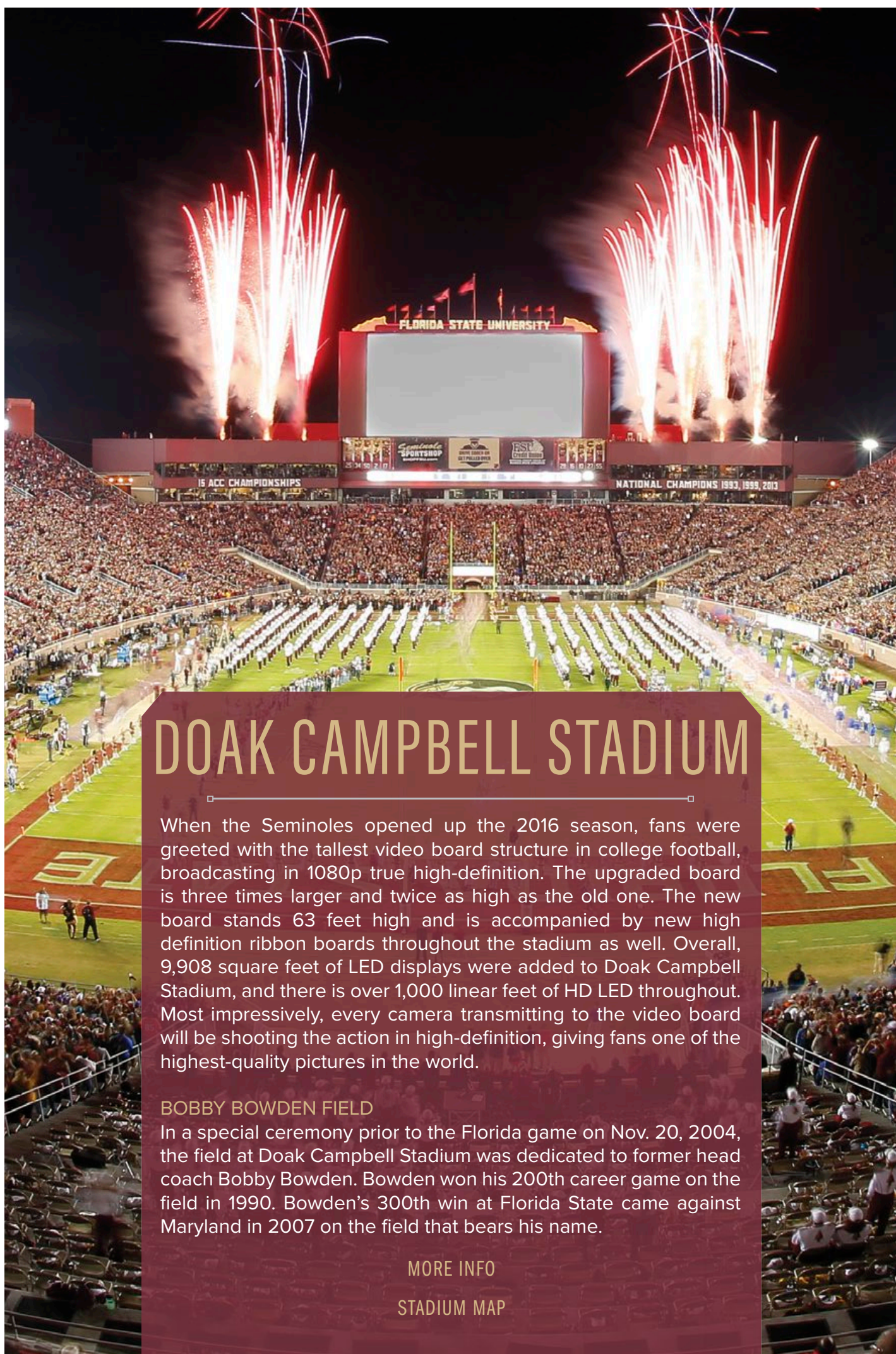

DOAK CAMPBELL STADIUM

When the Seminoles opened up the 2016 season, fans were greeted with the tallest video board structure in college football, broadcasting in 1080p true high-definition. The upgraded board is three times larger and twice as high as the old one. The new board stands 63 feet high and is accompanied by new high definition ribbon boards throughout the stadium as well. Overall, 9,908 square feet of LED displays were added to Doak Campbell Stadium, and there is over 1,000 linear feet of HD LED throughout. Most impressively, every camera transmitting to the video board will be shooting the action in high-definition, giving fans one of the highest-quality pictures in the world.

BOBBY BOWDEN FIELD

In a special ceremony prior to the Florida game on Nov. 20, 2004, the field at Doak Campbell Stadium was dedicated to former head coach Bobby Bowden. Bowden won his 200th career game on the field in 1990. Bowden's 300th win at Florida State came against Maryland in 2007 on the field that bears his name.

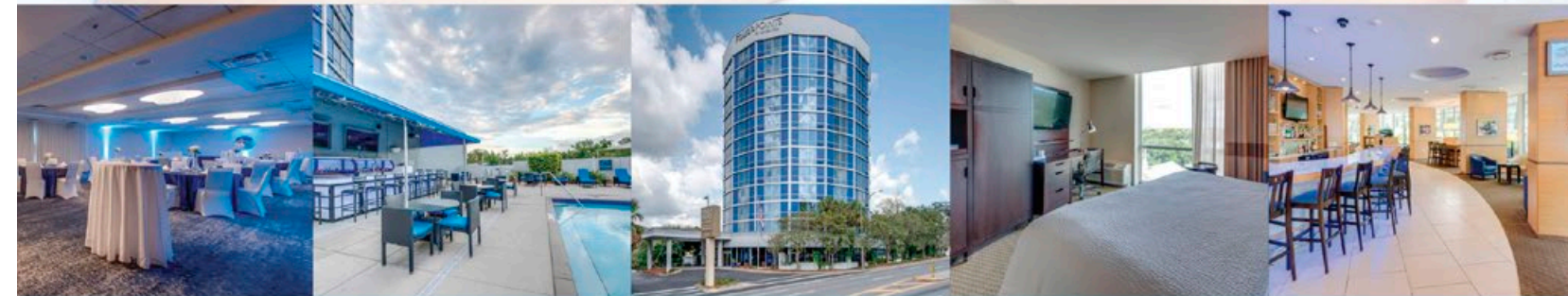

SEMINOLES IN THE NFL DRAFT

Derwin James became the 44th first round NFL Draft pick in Florida State history after he was selected 17th overall by the Los Angeles Chargers. FSU tied for fifth in the nation with six selections in 2018, the program's most since an ACC-record 11 were taken in 2015.

The Seminoles have had 14 defensive linemen drafted since 2008 after Derrick Nnadi and Josh Sweat were selected in 2018. Rick Leonard was the third offensive tackle and fifth offensive lineman drafted from FSU in the last four years.

FLORIDA STATE UNIVERSITY

Florida State University is an elite, research-intensive, public institution and one of just two preeminent universities in Florida. Located in Tallahassee, Florida's capital city, the university affords students and faculty opportunities for interaction with state and federal agencies for internships, research and part-time employment, as well as numerous social, cultural and recreational activities. FSU's welcoming campus is located on the oldest continuous site of higher education in Florida, in a community that fosters free inquiry and embraces diversity.

BEGINNINGS

Florida State was established as the Seminary West of the Suwannee by an act of the Florida Legislature in 1851. The institution first offered instruction at the postsecondary level in 1857. In 1905, the Buckman Act reorganized higher education in the state and designated the Tallahassee school as the Florida Female College. In 1909, it was renamed Florida State College for Women. In 1947, the school returned to coeducational status, and the name was changed to Florida State University.

41,900 & COUNTING

In 1946, there were 2,583 students enrolled. Today, our nearly 42,000 students, of whom about 8,000 are graduate and professional students, come from across the nation and from more than 130 countries around the world.

One of the nation's most dynamic research universities, Florida State University — with the Carnegie Foundation's highest designation, Doctoral Universities: Highest Research Activity — offers a distinctive academic environment built on its unique heritage, championship athletics and prime location in the heart of the state capital.

The faculty includes members of the National Academy of Sciences, the National Academy of Engineering, the National Academy of Medicine and the American Academy of Arts & Sciences; Pulitzer Prize winners; Oscar and Emmy winners; and Guggenheim, Fulbright and National Endowment for the Humanities fellows.

Florida State faculty members attract more than \$200 million a year in research dollars.

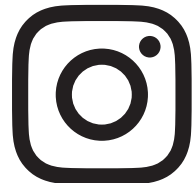

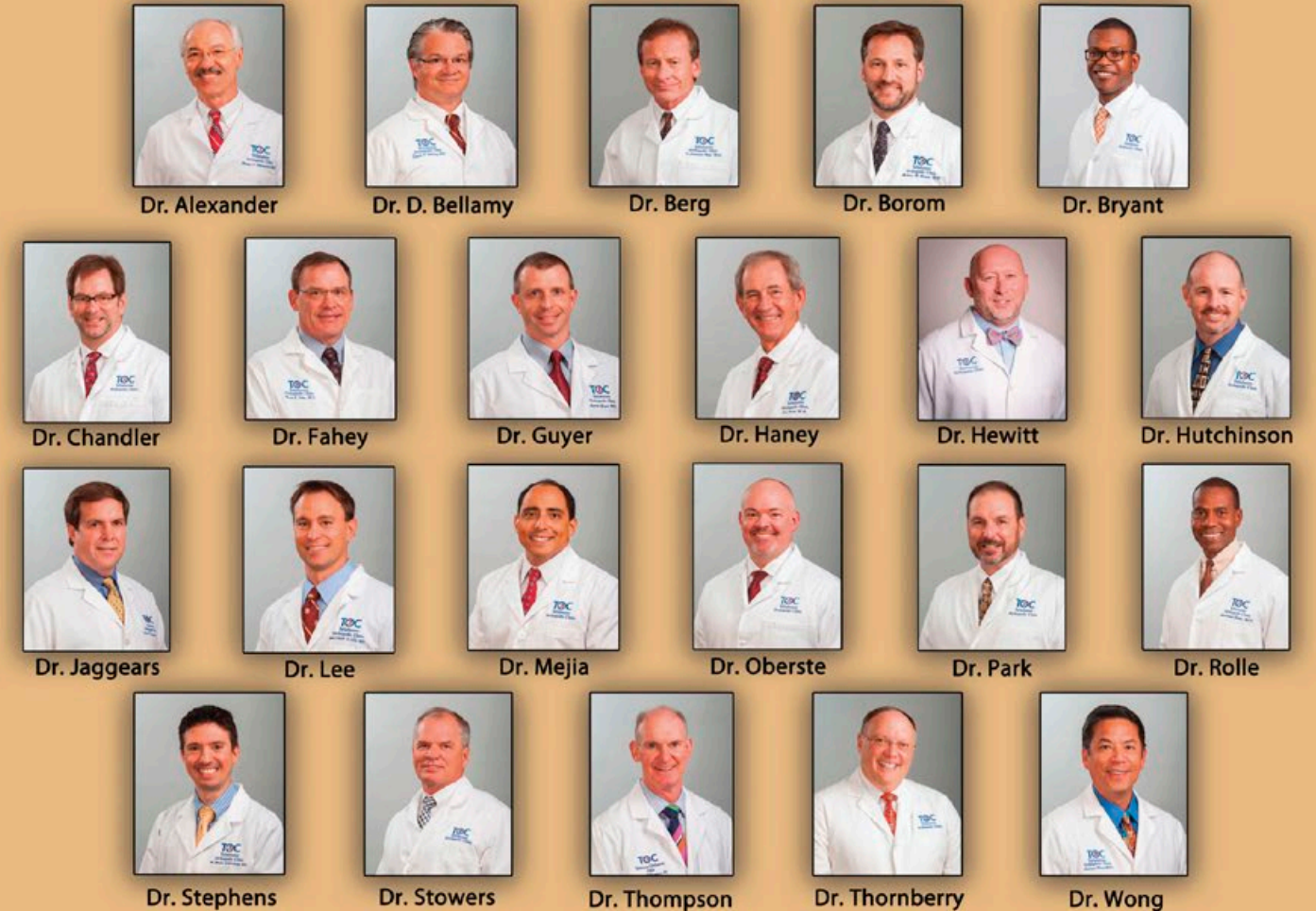
