## UF runs to victory

The University of Florida's cross country team, led by George Bridgers and Brian Quinn outran the Seminole marathoners 30-27 in Gainesville Saturday afternoon in a dual meet.

The Tribe managed to win four of the top six places, but it wasn't enough as Bridgers and Quinn finished one-two respectively, to give the Gators the margin of victory.

Florida State's Bobby Brooks, Bobby James, Del Ramers, and Bobby Burr were third, fourth, fifth and sixth, respectively. The meet wrapped up the season for the Tribe while the Gators must give a shot at the Southeastern Conference Cross Country title.

The lose was the only dual meet loss the Seminoles suffered all year. For the season's invitationals, the Tribe picked up two firsts and a second. The Seminoles won the South Alabama and Florida invitationals and placed second in its own.

Bridgers had to be the difference of defeat to the Seminoles as he missed the Florida and FSU invitationals. Saturday, he ran a course record of 25.10 and that will do it to you every time.
