

FSU Golfers Drop First Two Matches

Indians Beaten by Linksman From Mercer and Stetson

Florida State University's linksman went down to defeat in their first two matches of the year at the hands of Stetson and Mercer.

On March 22 at the Tallahassee Country club the FSU golfers lost a close match to the Stetson Hatters 18½-12½. Five days later the Indians met Mercer here and were barely edged 9½-8½ playing without the services of state intercollegiate champ, Sonny Tinney.

Commenting on the match against Mercer, golf coach Ed Burleson said that he was well pleased with the play of his team. Eddie

Andrews, captain, shot a 74 to win his match against Sam Glassman of Mercer and drew praise for his performance.

Mercer's Jack Morgan, undefeated in individual match play in college competition this year won over Hank Mercer 2 and 1. Both golfers shot a three over par 75.
